UTI Foundation Exton, PA Campus Tuition Scholarship Information Sheet

Objective:

To provide tuition grants-in-aid to students who seek to enroll at Universal Technical Institute's Exton, Pennsylvania campus, who show financial need and who reflect a true commitment to converting their passion for automobiles and trucks into a career as a professional technician. This program is funded through the UTI Foundation, a separate charitable organization devoted to supporting qualifying UTI students with the financial assistance required to complete technical training.

Criteria for awarding the scholarship:

Enrolled students who meet all other admissions requirements for the Universal Technical Institute Exton, Pennsylvania campus and ALL the criteria below, may apply for this \$2,500-\$3,500 tuition grant-in-aid (applied to the student's tuition, prorated over the entire term of the student's program):

To determine your eligibility for this scholarship program, you must:

1. have completed your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid), (*for questions on the completion or approval of your FAFSA, call the Financial Aid Department at 1-866-609-6930*);
2. be enrolled to start classes at the UTI Exton, Pennsylvania campus;
3. reflect financial need as assessed through the information provided in the FAFSA;
4. have a letter of recommendation from an employer, guidance counselor or instructor;
5. clearly express a commitment to professional success through the application essay; and
6. submit the completed application and letter of recommendation by the deadline

Process and Rules:

Information regarding this scholarship will be posted on the UTI Foundation website (www.utifoundation.net) and linked to the UTI Corporate website.

Any enrolled UTI Exton, Pennsylvania campus student meeting the criteria may apply. Funding and total awards available for this program are limited. Students will complete an application including essay, along with a letter of recommendation and submit it to the UTI Foundation. Students who apply and meet all requirements will be considered for this grant-in-aid. Determinations of who will receive the award will be based on a complete review of all applications received by the deadline. The deadline for **RECEIPT** of the application and all required attachments by the UTI Foundation is **FIVE WEEKS prior to the student's scheduled start date.**

Of those applications received, each will be reviewed for completeness and accuracy of all information provided. Of those viable applications, the awards will be distributed to those students who present the greatest financial need combined with the best likelihood of success through the ideas expressed in the essay portion of the application and reference letter. Applicants will be notified via U.S. mail after deadline date.

The award is provided by the UTI Foundation and is applied directly to the student's tuition. The award is spread out over the term of the program and any unused portion of the scholarship will be pro-rated and returned to the UTI Foundation.
