### **Mission:**

The UTI Foundation is the independent philanthropic arm of Universal Technical Institute (UTI) with a mission to enable individuals to complete technical training leading to career success through scholarships, grants, public service education programs, life-long learning and the creation of a nationwide alumni support network.

### **Goals:**

- To enhance post-technical education through a support network providing career development;
- To recognize technical achievement and;
- To increase awareness and support of technical education within the community and industry.

### **Scholarships:**

There are few things as important to success in life as a quality education. The goal of RedlineRevolution.org is to radically change the traditional driver education focal point to the craft and science of driving rather than a focus on the "rules of the road".
