



## UTI Foundation/NASCAR Foundation Brienne Davis Scholarship Information Sheet

### **Objective of the UTI Foundation/NASCAR Foundation Brienne Davis Scholarship Program:**

1. To provide one \$10,000 scholarship annually for a qualified/eligible female student who wishes to attend any Universal Technical Institute campus to assist in financing their training.
2. To fill the technician pipeline with qualified and motivated women to the NASCAR industry.
3. To increase the number of women in the NASCAR industry and make more women aware of the possibilities of a NASCAR career.

### **Scholarship Criteria:**

Available to female students from anywhere in the US. A scholarship applicant must:

1. Exhibit the traits and attitude that will make them a good future employee by providing a letter of recommendation from an employer, guidance counselor or instructor.
2. Complete a 250 word essay to clearly express financial need, how she shares the passion of Brienne Davis for the sport of NASCAR, and how the scholarship will enable her to contribute to the motorsports industry.
3. Submit a completed application by the deadline date.

### **Scholarship Notes:**

- Scholarships will be awarded as a *grant-in-aid* (applied to the student's program tuition and prorated over the remaining term of the program) while maintaining a minimum *3.0 GPA and 95% attendance* during the course of their enrollment.
- There will be one scholarship awarded annually.
- The UTI Foundation/NASCAR Foundation Brienne Davis Scholarship information sheet and application will be placed on the UTI Foundation web site ([www.utifoundation.net](http://www.utifoundation.net)).
- The UTI Foundation Scholarship Committee will select the best top candidate for the scholarship. A local NASCAR official may be present to award the scholarship.
- All donations to the UTI Foundation/NASCAR Foundation Brienne Davis Scholarship Program are fully tax deductible. Donors will receive a thank you letter from the UTI Foundation which serves as their tax receipt.
