Activity-centered learning events can be designed in a fraction of the time it takes to design presentation centered ones. Participants will be tested to determine their own learning style, and will experience a fun learning activity. Many examples of learning events will be discussed and how they are applicable at the high school level. Participants will receive a copy of "The Accelerated Learning Handbook" by Dave Meier. Two hours.

## 3. SHOW ME THE MONEY - FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR THE POST SECONDARY TECHNICAL INSTITUTE STUDENTS

Many professional school counselors are very familiar with Financial Aid and scholarship opportunities for their traditional college bound students but may not be as proficient in what is available for the students planning on attending a technical institute after graduation. This workshop covers all the Title Four opportunities while exploring alternative loans, grants and scholarships. One hour, handouts.

## 4. STEM – SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING AND MATH

Are your students taking enough high level math, science, engineering and technology related courses to compete in the global workplace? The National STEM initiative encourages us to place more emphasis on these subjects. How can we do this? In this interactive workshop you'll learn how to incorporate more STEM in your high school guidance curriculum and how to provide your teachers with unique and fun ideas that will help students see the relationship between their courses and future career pathways.
