



Ryan G. Kehoe was the youngest of six children and the only boy. He loved 4-wheelers, snowmobiles, old cars and motorcycles. He graduated from High School in 2001.

In the fall of 2004, Ryan decided to pursue his passion for motorcycles and he attended MMI in Orlando, Florida. After graduating from MMI in February of 2006, he returned to Michigan and worked at Northwoods Harley-Davidson as a Service Technician. Ryan absolutely loved his job and took great pride in his work. He was an honest, hard working guy with a great sense of humor.

On May 12, 2007, at the age of 24, Ryan was riding his Harley home from work when his life was taken by a careless driver. In honor of Ryan's life, family and friends started the annual Ryan's Ride. The ride's goal is to promote motorcycle awareness and remind drivers to safely share the roads with motorcyclists. Proceeds from each ride will be given as scholarships to other individuals pursuing similar dreams.

Objective:

This \$1,000 tuition grant-in-aid was established by Ryan's family to help a student from Michigan pursue their educational goal of becoming a motorcycle technician at the MMI Orlando, FL campus.

Criteria for awarding the scholarship:

Applicants meeting ALL the criteria below may apply for this \$1,000 grant-in-aid (applied to the student's tuition, prorated over the entire term of the student's program). There are limited funds for this tuition scholarship during the funded period. To be eligible, a student **must:**

1. Have graduated from a Michigan High School.
2. Be currently enrolled in the Harley-Davidson program at the MMI Orlando, FL campus.
3. Have completed at least 3 months of your educational program.
4. Have a 95% or better attendance record.
5. Have a GPA of 3.5 or better.
6. Submit a letter of recommendation from an employer, guidance counselor or instructor.
7. Submit your completed application, essay and letter of recommendation by the deadline date*. (See below for details)

Process and Rules:

Information regarding this scholarship will be posted on the UTI Foundation website (www.utifoundation.net) and linked to the UTI Corporate website.

Any student meeting the criteria may apply. Students will submit their completed application with essay to the UTI Foundation. Students who apply and meet all requirements will be considered for this grant-in-aid. Determinations of who will receive the award will be based on a complete review of all applications received prior to the deadline.

Of those applications received, each will be reviewed for completeness and authenticity of all information provided. Of those viable applications, the award will be distributed to the student who most closely aligns with the scholarship's criteria/objectives, as expressed in the essay portion of the application. All viable applications will be reviewed by the UTI Foundation and a representative of Ryan Kehoe's family. Applicants will be notified via U.S. mail.
